Session II Afterschool Offerings (November 4-January 24,2020)

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students,

We have attached our afterschool program offerings for session II. All programs are free, and a healthy meal will be provided. **Please bring back your registration form back right away because classes fill up quickly.** Your child will receive a confirmation of what program(s) he or she is enrolled in by Friday, October 29th. Please note that **21C classes** do not meet on Wed, December 11th and Wed, Jan 8th, but there will be early release activities from 12:15-3:00 on these two days. The early release registration forms for Dec 11th have already been sent out. The early release forms for January will be sent out in early December. **Please sign up in advance for the activities on the early release days.** Please also be aware that there are no afterschool classes the week of December 16th and January 2nd.

Our afterschool program is a partnership between the Winooski School District, the PTO, the City of Winooski, and our 21C grant. Most programs are taught by licensed teachers and provide enrichment opportunities for students in the areas of literacy, math, science, social studies, technology, wellness, and the arts.

On the **first day** of their afterschool programs for each session, participating students in grades 1-5 can go directly to the room where their afterschool class is being held. Ms. Thomas will be in the hallway in case students need help finding their room. Participating students in Kindergarten will meet Ms. Magowan in the front lobby. Attendance will be taken when students are at their assigned classroom locations. You will receive a phone call if your child has been in school that day, but doesn't attend his/her afterschool program.

Please let us know when your child will be absent from his/her program and/or if your contact information changes during this session. Please call 802-655-0411 (JFK Office) if you need to contact us from 3-4 pm.

Parents and guardians are always welcome to stop in to meet afterschool program teachers and to see what wonderful learning is happening. We are always looking for volunteers to help afterschool teachers with their programs so please let us know if you are interested. We are looking forward to a great session of afterschool programs!

MONDAY CLASS OPPORTUNITIES FOR 3RD-5TH GRADERS

Music Inspires Group Violin Class (for grades 3-5)

Ms. Jancova and Ms. Poland

The students' who participated in the first session are automatically enrolled in the second session unless you tell us not to enroll your child. This small, engaging class allows your child to discover the excitement of violin playing in a fun and supportive group setting. Students will learn the basics of violin playing and music literacy, while learning great music! This class is a full year commitment, meeting twice a week (Mondays and Thursdays) for sessions 1 & 2 and once a week (Thursdays) for sessions 3 & 4. Performance opportunities will be provided throughout the year in addition to sharing days, which will take place at the end of each session for family and friends. The class is presented in partnership with the Vermont Youth Orchestra Association and violins and materials are provided free of charge. This class focuses on the Creativity GX, in the area of Performing Arts.
