Next Week

On March 2nd, Governor Scott announced that school staff would be eligible for the COVID19 vaccinations. Next week, Monday and Tuesday, approximately 35 **JFK** staff members will be getting the second with COVID-19 vaccine, possibility of experiencing moderate to severe side effects. This will impact ½ of our staff and will create severe staffing shortages. Because of this shortage, our leadership team has made the decision that all students in Kindergarten through 5th grade will move to a fully remote learning schedule on Monday, April 5 through Wednesday, April 7.

Tuesday, April 6th, are parent teacher conferences. All conferences will take place over Zoom. Moving to a fully remote learning schedule on Monday, April 5 through Wednesday, April 7 will not affect conferences. By now you should have received a conference confirmation from your student's classroom teacher. If you need to change your conference time, please contact the teacher directly.

At conferences, teachers will ask you if you have filled out the Family Survey. The survey is attached to this newsletter. We are currently working with community partners to develop project based learning for students. This means that students will be off campus on Mondays and Wednesday for place based, outdoor learning experiences. This opportunity is going to make summer school fantastic and engaging for our students. 
