Annual Surveys

Each spring, I ask our families, students and staff to complete a survey. The survey asks about the culture and climate at JFK, educational practices, and communication.

Each student completes the student survey in their classroom. Older students complete the survey independently, and younger students complete it 1:1 with an adult.

The entire JFK staff is asked to complete the staff survey before they leave for the summer.

All of our families are also asked to fill out a family survey. So far we have had 27 families complete the survey this year.

The information that we gather from the surveys is vital to shaping our work for the next school year. Each June the JFK Leadership team looks at the new data from each survey, looks for trends within the multi-year data, and develops plans for the coming school year.

Incoming Kindergarten Students

We are getting ready for next year's Kindergarten students! I held a Kindergarten Information Zoom for our English speaking families before vacation. I will be holding two more informational Zooms for families on Monday, May 3rd at 1pm and Saturday, May 8th at 1pm. We will be holding Kindergarten Screening this year on Wednesday, June 9th. Children who will be five years of age prior to September 1, 2021, should attend this screening. Kindergarten registration and screening will be at School on Wednesday June 9 8:00-1:30. Please call the J.F.K. office at 655-0411 to make an appointment. All appointments are 45 minutes.

Please bring your student, student's birth certificate, (or I-94 if your child was born in a country that doesn't issue birth certificates), updated immunization record, your student's Social Security number, and proof of residency to the appointment. While your incoming kindergarten student is being screened, families will have time to complete the online registration if they have not done so already and fill out a sheet to help us learn about your student.

If you have an incoming Kindergarten student and cannot come to the screening on June 9th, please call the JFK office. We will take your information and one of the Kindergarten teachers will contact you to make alternative plans.

Summer School

JFK will be running Summer School during the month of July this summer.
