Winter Clothing

As the temperatures outside drop, I wanted to take this opportunity to remind our families of a few things.

At JFK, we believe that out students need time to play at recess, preferably outside. The opportunity for physical activity can improve student's focus, social skills, and over all well being. The opportunity to play helps students burn energy, develop social skills, experience fresh air and sunlight. Our students go outside for recess unless it is 10 degrees or below with the wind chill, or it is raining. It is important that students come to school with all the gear they need to play outside. Students should come to school with a winter coat, snow pants when it is cold and/or snowy, winter boots, a hat, and mittens. While we cannot force students to put their winter gear on, we can highly encourage them and remind them that they will be very cold without it. Please have conversations with your student about wearing their winter clothing at recess.
