# **Ice Cream**

I want to inform you of an important change regarding cafeteria offerings that will take effect when students return to school on January 2, 2025. After careful consideration, we have made the decision to discontinue the sale of ice cream in the cafeteria for JFK students.

We understand that this may come as a disappointment to some, and we want to share the reasoning behind this decision. Our primary goal is to ensure that every student has a positive and inclusive experience at school. Over time, we have observed that some students are choosing not to eat their lunches in order to purchase ice cream, which can negatively impact their overall nutrition and social well-being. Additionally, there have been concerns about inequities that arise when ice cream is available only to those who can bring in extra money, leading to exclusion and negative social interactions among students.

As a school that values equity, we believe it's essential to create an environment where every student feels included, regardless of their financial situation. Our commitment to fostering a sense of belonging for all students is a guiding principle in every decision we make. While we understand that some students may miss this treat, we are confident that this change will help to better support the well-being of all our students.
