The Winooski School District is proud to offer the **802 Smiles Network On-Site Dental Program** again this year! This program provides students with preventive dental services—including cleanings, fluoride treatments, and sealants—right at school during the day.

Benefits:

- Students receive care without needing to leave school.
- Parents don't have to miss work to transport their child to a dental office.

Please note, this program **does not replace regular dental check-ups or X-rays** with your child's dentist. If your child is seen at school, a report will be sent to their regular dentist.

How to Enroll:

- Complete the consent and medical history forms, available in the Health Office or on the PowerSchool Portal.

Additional Services:

The 802 Smiles Network (formerly the Tooth Tutor Program) works to ensure every student has access to comprehensive dental care, including preventive, restorative, and continuous care in a dental office. We assist families without a dentist in finding a dental home and provide free dental screenings with parental consent.
